An easy-to-grow, garden-worthy plant, anise hyssop reseeds readily to fill in those pesky gaps in your landscape. Yes, the finger-like flowers are lovely, but in addition, the leaves have a nice, licorice-y mint scent and can be used to garnish fruit salads and parfaits.
