



Hairy Mountain Mint

Pycnanthemum verticillatum var. pilosum

- Light: Sun, Partial Sun
- Soil: Loam, Sand, Clay
- Moisture: Medium, Medium-Dry
- Benefits: Birds, Pollinators, Bees, Butterflies, Deer Resistant
- Height: 3'
- Blooms: July, August
- Zones: 4, 5, 6, 7, 8
- Color: White
- Spacing: 3'
- Root: Rhizome



This adaptable plant is especially good for pollinators, and it's always nice to have some white in the garden, but be aware that it can spread. Maybe give it some room to run. Divinely minty, to the point that you can smell it as you brush by the plant.
