Poke Milkweed

Asclepias exaltata

Light: Partial shade, shade

Soil: Loam, Sand

Moisture Medium

Benefits: Birds, Pollinators, Butterflies, Host, Deer

Resistant

Height: 3'-5'

Blooms: June, July

Zones: 3, 4, 5, 6, 7

Color: White

Spacing: 1-2'

Root: Taproot

The only milkweed for shade, poke milkweed is found along woodland edges and stream banks in the wild. It adds diversity to a shade garden, and with its height and unusual leaves, it's great among ferns and sedges. As you would expect, it's a monarch butterfly host plant, and while it spreads in its happy place, it's not aggressive.
