Tall Boneset

Eupatorium altissimum

Light:	Sun, partial sun
Soil:	Sand, loam, clay, gravel
Moisture:	Medium-wet, Medium, Medium-Dry
Benefits:	Beneficial insects, deer resistant
Height:	2'-6'
Blooms:	Aug-Oct
Zones:	4-9
Color:	White
Spacing:	2'
Root:	Rhizomes

A rugged, hairy plant of prairies and open woodlands, tall boneset can add a white grace note to your meadow at a time when yellow is the major key. It's drought tolerant once established and spreads by seed in the garden. Word is it can hold its own with Canada goldenrod.
