# Sky Blue Aster

*Aster azureus, Symphyotrichum oolentangiense*

Light:	Full Sun, Partial
Soil:	Loam, Sand
Moisture:	Dry-Medium
Benefits:	Pollinators, Birds, Butterflies, Host Plant
Height:	2' to 3'
Blooms:	August-October
Zones:	3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8
Color:	Lavendar Blue
Spacing:	1'
Root:	Fibrous

A delicate and appealing addition to the fall garden, sky blue aster goes great with showy goldenrod, which blooms about the same time. It's easy to grow, drought tolerant, and brings a welcome shot of blue to a very yellow time of year.
