



# Boneset

*Eupatorium perfoliatum*

Light:	Sun, partial sun
Soil:	Sand, loam, clay, gravel
Moisture:	Wet, medium wet, medium
Benefits:	Beneficial insects, butterflies, pollinators, deer resistant
Height:	4'
Blooms:	July-Sept
Zones:	3-8
Color:	White
Spacing:	1'-2'
Root:	Fibrous

The pure white flowers of boneset provide landing pads for all sorts of pollinators (like the azure butterfly pictured), as well as adding an airy white presence in the garden. Lovely paired with the blazing stars—think dense, prairie, or meadow, which like damp sites. It earned its name for the leaves' reputed ability to set and heal bones.
